SUBJECT : AN ORDER REPEALING PRI OFFICE ORDER NO. 6, s. 2022 AND RECONSTITUTING THE INSTRUCTORS' PERFORMANCE EVALUATION (IPE) COMMITTEE

DATE : 14 FEBRUARY 2023

Pursuant to PRI Office Order No. 5, series of 2022, otherwise known as the "Guidelines for the Evaluation of Instructors' Performance in the Preparation for and Conduct of the Training Courses of the PRI", an IPE Committee is hereby established. The said committee, whose main function is the regular conduct of the evaluation for current and upcoming instructors of the PRI, shall be comprised of the following, with their respective functions:

- a. Committee Head – to supervise and facilitate the proper utilization of the IPE methods and tools, and the recommendation of the committee members.
- b. Training Division (TD) Representatives – to provide technical expertise and determine the competency of the Instructors under evaluation to teach the subject/topic.
- c. Certification and Accreditation Division (CAD) Representative – to provide secondary insight to the committee as a member outside of the TD.
- d. Research and Development Division (RDD) Representatives – to evaluate the Instructors on their adherence to the core values that the PRI teaches its trainees, as the Instructors are expected to be the prime examples of the knowledge and values that the PRI imparts in its training.
- e. Administrative and Finance Section (AFS) Representatives – to maintain the requirements, documents, and records and shall serve as the secretariat during the evaluation, which shall include the preparation and submission of reports.

Consequently, the following personnel are hereby designated as Committee Head and Members, respectively:

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

In order to maintain confidentiality, impartiality, and transparency, all members of the IPE Committee shall be evaluated in the classroom and/or online observation, announced or unannounced, and on a semi-annual panel using the methods and tools outlined pursuant to PRI Office Order No 5, s. 2022. Any IPE Committee member who is subject to evaluation shall be temporarily removed from the same and shall not be allowed to rate his/her own performance. In addition, if the IPE Committee deems it appropriate, a third-party entity may be tapped to separately intervene and conduct its own evaluation, providing additional insights and perspective to the IPE Committee.

Except for the foregoing additions, all other provisions of PRI Office Order No. 5, s. 2022 shall remain unchanged. Moreover, this Order repeals PRI Officer Order No. 6, s. 2022.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
